Sorting of recyclable waste



- **YELLOW bin for Paper and cardboard and Recyclable materials:** newspapers, magazines, cardboard boxes, etc. plastics (check the recycling symbol at the bottom of the item), metals such as aluminum cans and small iron or steel objects, as well as food cartons.
- **GREEN bin for Glass:** all types of glass, except for mirrors, windows, and ceramics.

Management of non-recyclable household waste



- Use the **GRAY bin for waste** that cannot be recycled, such as certain plastic packaging, paper tissues, and other small household waste. Place them in a tied trash bag.

Use of compost buckets



- **Small compost buckets** are available upon request at the reception to collect organic waste such as fruit and vegetable peels, coffee grounds, eggshells, etc. Once full, empty your bucket into the large wooden bin provided for this purpose in the campsite parking area. This compost will be used to enrich the soils of our campsite.

Specific use sorting points



- The **small trash bins** located at the dishwashing and laundry stations are intended only for crumbs and small dish waste. Keep larger waste to place in the large containers. Used batteries should be deposited in the box in front of the reception.



Minimize your waste by using reusable products. Educate your camping companions about these practices so that everyone can contribute to the collective effort.
